

Application for Certificate of Completion for the University-wide Education Program for those completing the course in March

Students who will be graduated from university or completing graduate school in March, 2024 (including those who will withdraw from the doctorate program after completing the course requirements under the program) will be issued with a Certification of Completion for the programs listed below, if they have satisfied all the necessary requirements and have completed the required application processes.

- Application Procedure – Apply through UTAS (Click "Qualifications connection" of the "Course" menu, and submit your application from "Application for University-wide Education Program".) Please refer to "Web Application for University-wide Education Programs using UTAS")
- Application Period – Monday, October 2 to Tuesday, October 31, 2023

Important

Even if you have applied for a Certification of Completion before, a certificate will not be issued unless you complete the application in the above mentioned period. If you wish to graduate/complete graduate school in March, 2024, please make sure to complete all the necessary applications this time.

Please note that even if application is made, if you do not satisfy all the requirements for the program completion, or you fail to graduate/complete graduate school, a Certificate of Completion will not be issued.

〈To students who have taken courses approved by the Barrier-Free Education Program〉

The Barrier-Free Education Program changed its name to the Diversity and Inclusion Education Program since AY2023. Students who have taken approved courses in the Barrier-Free Education Program should apply for a certificate of the Diversity and Inclusion Education Program.

If a student has earned at least one accredited course in the Barrier-Free Education Program prior to AY2023, the Barrier-Free Education Program can issue a certificate of completion. Details will be provided after the certificate application.
